1. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE USE OF THIS SITE

Introduction. PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE USING THE SERVICES PROVIDED IN THE SITE. 7.1 WITH WHOM WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Dragnet may send your Personal Data to a department or office other than the one to which you have sent your application. In addition, we may disclose your Personal Data to the following third parties in any country:

Agents, advisors or third party service suppliers providing services to support the Company's business operations under a duty of confidentiality to the Company;

Governmental, judicial and other bodies and authorities in compliance with applicable laws and regulations or otherwise;

Lawyers/solicitors in connection with legal proceedings, to obtain legal advice, or to support the Company's Legal rights;
